We are pleased to provide the 2007 *Prescribing Guide* as a useful reference and informational tool. The *Prescribing Guide* can assist practitioners in selecting clinically appropriate and cost-effective products for their patients.

The drugs represented have been reviewed by a National Pharmacy and Therapeutics (P&T) Committee and are approved for inclusion. The *Prescribing Guide* is reflective of current medical practice as of the date of review.

The information contained in this *Prescribing Guide* and its appendices is provided solely for the convenience of medical providers. We do not warrant or assure accuracy of such information nor is it intended to be comprehensive in nature. This *Prescribing Guide* is not intended to be a substitute for the knowledge, expertise, skill, and judgment of the medical provider in their choice of prescription drugs. All the information in the *Prescribing Guide* is provided as a reference for drug therapy selection. Specific drug selection for an individual patient rests solely with the prescriber.

## PREFACE

The *Prescribing Guide* is organized by sections. Each section is divided by therapeutic drug class primarily defined by mechanism of action. Products are listed by generic name with brand name for reference only. Unless exceptions are noted, generally all applicable dosage forms and strengths of the drug cited are included in the *Prescribing Guide*. Generics should be considered the first line of prescribing.

Individual pharmacy benefit plans may impose restrictions or not reimburse some products. In addition, over-the-counter (OTC) products, with the exception of insulin and diabetes monitoring products, are usually not included in the pharmacy benefit. OTC products are listed for informational purposes.

Drugs represented in the *Prescribing Guide* may have varying cost to the plan participant. Generic medications typically are available at the lowest cost, brand name medications on the *Prescribing Guide* will generally cost more than generics, and brand name medications not on the *Prescribing Guide* will generally cost the most.

The tiered format places drugs into tiers or levels of cost sharing by the plan participant in the following manner:

Tier 1: Lowest plan participant co-payment: **All generic drugs**, including those on the *Prescribing Guide*.

Tier 2: Intermediate plan participant co-payment: Preferred brand name products on the *Prescribing Guide* selected for Tier 2.

Tier 3: Highest plan participant co-payment: Brand name products on the **Prescribing Guide** not selected for Tier 2, and all non-preferred brand name products. In most cases, there will be reasonable alternatives in Tier 1 or Tier 2 for products found in this highest tier.

## PHARMACY AND THERAPEUTICS (P&T) COMMITTEE

The services of an independent National Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee ("P&T Committee") are utilized to approve safe and clinically effective drug therapies. The P&T Committee is an external advisory body of experts from across the United States. The P&T Committee's voting members include physicians, pharmacists, a pharmacoeconomist and a medical ethicist all of whom have a broad background of clinical and academic expertise regarding prescription drugs. Employees with significant clinical expertise are invited to meet with the P&T Committee, but no Caremark employee may vote on issues before the P&T Committee. Voting members of the P&T Committee must disclose any financial relationship or conflicts of interest with any pharmaceutical manufacturers.

## DRUG LIST PRODUCT DESCRIPTIONS

To assist in understanding which specific strengths and dosage forms are on the **Prescribing Guide**, examples are noted below. The general principles shown in the examples can then usually be extended to other entries in the book. Any exceptions are noted.

**Products on the *Prescribing Guide* include all strengths and dosage forms of the cited brand name product.**

*lansoprazole*

*Prevacid*

Capsules, oral suspension, oral disintegrating tablets, and all strengths of Prevacid would be covered by this listing.

**When a strength or dosage form is specified, only the specified strength and dosage form is on the *Prescribing Guide*. Other strengths/dosage forms of the reference product are not.**

*ciprofloxacin susp*

*Cipro Susp*

The brand name suspension formulation is on the **Prescribing Guide** but the brand name tablets are not.

**Extended-release and delayed-release products require their own entry.**

*bupropion ext-rel*

*Wellbutrin XL*

The long-acting product Wellbutrin SR is not on the **Prescribing Guide** based upon the Wellbutrin XL entry. Similarly, the brand name product Wellbutrin immediate-release is not on the **Prescribing Guide**.

**Dosage forms on the *Prescribing Guide* will be consistent with the category and use where listed.**

*neomycin/polymyxin B/hydrocortisone*      *Cortisporin*

As listed in the OTIC section, limited to the otic solution and suspension. From this entry the ophthalmic solution and ophthalmic ointment, and the topical cream cannot be assumed to be on the **Prescribing Guide** unless there are entries for these products in the OPTHALMIC and DERMATOLOGY sections of the **Prescribing Guide**.

## GENERIC SUBSTITUTION

Generic substitution is a pharmacy action whereby a generic version is dispensed rather than a prescribed brand name product. Boldface type indicates generic availability. However, not all strengths or dosage forms of the generic name in boldface type may be generically available. In addition, boldface type may indicate that the brand name cited is a generic. Examples of the latter include Levoxyl and Trivora.

One way to reduce out-of-pocket cost is by requesting a generic drug. Generic drugs are usually priced lower than their brand name equivalents. Generic drugs are:

- Approved by the U.S Food and Drug Administration for safety and effectiveness, and are manufactured under the same strict standards that apply to brand name drugs.
- Tested in humans to assure the generic is absorbed into the bloodstream in a similar time and amount compared to the brand name drug. Generics may be different from the brand in size, color, and inactive ingredients, but this does not alter their effectiveness or ability to be absorbed just like the brand name drug.
- Manufactured in the same strength and dosage form as the brand name drugs.

When a generic drug is substituted for a brand name drug, you can expect the generic to have the same clinical effect and safety profile as the brand name drug. Brand name drugs having a generic available may:

- Incur higher co-payment (tier 3)
- Require payment of the difference in price between generic and brand, in addition to co-payment
- Require mandatory generic dispensing
